Information: AirAudio Tips...

We've received two tips from Don in Montana on how he improved the AirAudio operation with his Garmin GPS.

1) Preventing the GreaseNinja Rubber Band from slipping off the Pick-up Mic.

Don made a hole in the provided 'GreaseNinja' Rubber Band and put the pick-up mic metal tube through the hole and then connected the plastic air tube to the pick-up mic metal tube. This prevents the GreaseNinja Band from slipping off the Pick-up Mic under any circumstance.

2) Eliminating unintentional GPS touch screen 'touches' by hand or clothing when attaching the Pick-up Mic or when riding.

Don placed a piece of sturdy cardboard over the screen after inputting his destination. The cardboard cover is held in place by the GreaseNinja Rubber Band. This worked very well for him, so he fashioned a piece of plastic instead of using cardboard.

We tried both of Don's ideas and they worked well for us.
